## **COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Registration Information**

The Polk County Health Department is now prepared to expand the COVID-19 vaccination of healthcare workers in **Polk County** in Phase 1A to additional groups. The healthcare workers that may now receive the COVID-19 vaccination include:

### **Vaccine Locations**

Vaccine is available at the several locations in Polk County. **ALL** locations will require that healthcare workers bring the following to their appointment:

- Mask: everyone will be required to wear one. If you do not have one, a mask will be provided to you.
- Photo form of **personal identification**: driver's license, passport, or state identification card **AND employment verification**: employer issued badge or identification or proof of licensure.
- If you are pregnant or lactating, you are required to consult with your Primary Care Physician beforehand and come with a note from them stating you are ok to receive the vaccine.

#### **Recommendations:**

Medical practices should prioritize their employees for vaccination based upon their risk, frequency, immediacy and duration of exposure to COVID-19, per the Iowa Department of Public Health Infectious Disease Advisory Committee (IDAC) recommendations. Employee vaccination times should be staggered so not everyone on your team is receiving the vaccine at the same time. We ask you to think about a priority system among staff within your organization. Staff who work directly with customers and the public or those who are in situations where the virus can be easily transmitted should receive the vaccine first before those who can continue to work from home. Practices should also prioritize staff with frequent, extended patient contact. Create a plan that looks at staff by the critical infrastructure within your operations. This will help to ensure continuity of operations for your staff.
